CHAPTER 6

COMMITTEES

§806.000. COMMITTEES.

- A. The Master and Wardens shall be a Charity Committee, and shall have the power to draw upon the Treasurer for any sum, not exceeding \$100 at any one time (or such greater amount as the Lodge may from time to time provide by a standing resolution), for the relief of a distressed worthy Mason and the wife, widow or orphan of a Master Mason.
- B. The Master, at the Stated Meeting next succeeding his installation, shall appoint an Auditing Committee, whose duty it shall be to examine all accounts presented against the Lodge and the books and records of the Treasurer and Secretary. Neither the Treasurer nor Secretary may serve on the Audit Committee.
- C. The Master, at the Stated Meeting next succeeding his installation, shall appoint a Delinquent Dues Committee to personally, or otherwise, interview each delinquent member, ascertain the cause, and work closely with the Master and officers in a continuing effort to effect the retention of all deserving members unable to pay.
- D. The Lodge may have such other committees as the Master or the Lodge may deem proper to appoint. All committees shall be appointed by the Master, unless the Lodge provides otherwise.
- E. All reports of committees shall be in writing.

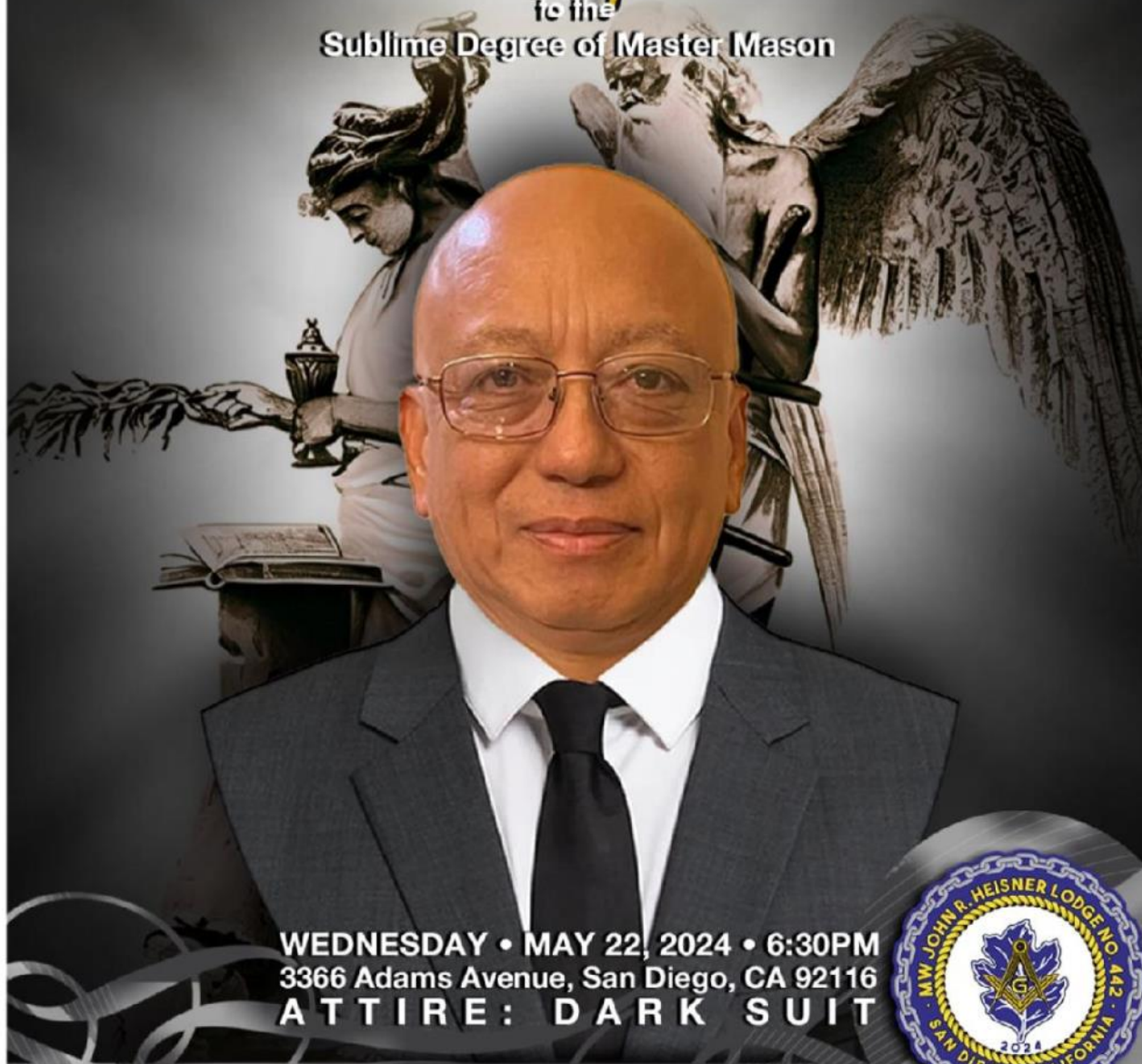
